- if your fish is caught your company information will be sent as the sponsor with the prize check to the fisherman who catches the fish

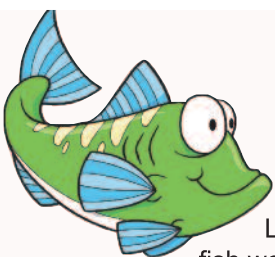
## Got Give-a-ways?

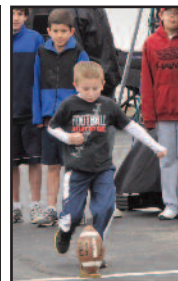

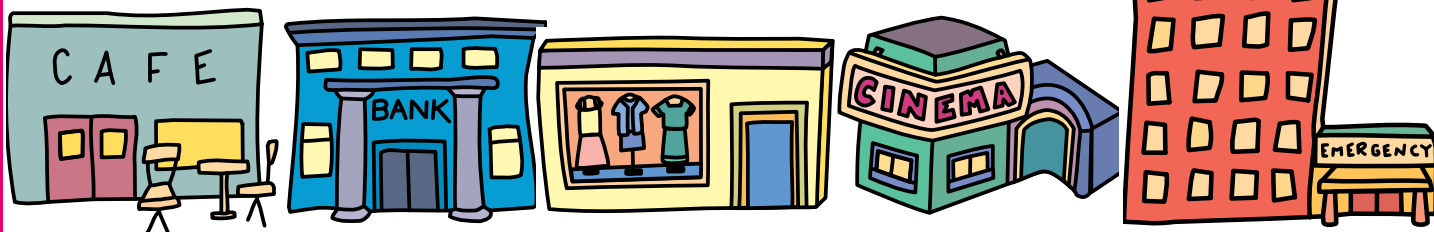
